



Enserva Responds to Tariffs Imposed on Exports to the US

February 1, 2025 – Enserva issued the following statement in response to tariffs being imposed on Canadian exports into the United States.

“These tariffs are a devastating blow to all Canadians. Any impediment to our longstanding trade relationship undermines the deeply integrated supply chain that has fueled economic growth in both Canada and the United States for decades.

There are many inputs and stages throughout the energy supply chain that will feel the full weight of the tariffs, which will undoubtedly threaten jobs, investment, and the economic ties that benefit both Canada and the United States.

The energy services, supply, and manufacturing sector provides the materials, technology, and expertise that powers industries on both sides of the border. From manufacturers in Ontario, to energy workers in Alberta and Saskatchewan, to suppliers in British Columbia, this is a direct hit to the Canadian workers who keep our economy moving and to the communities they live in.

These tariffs highlight how dangerous it is to have our energy sector limited to a single trading partner. Dozens of damaging federal policies over the past decade have handcuffed our industry, blocking our resources from reaching global markets.
